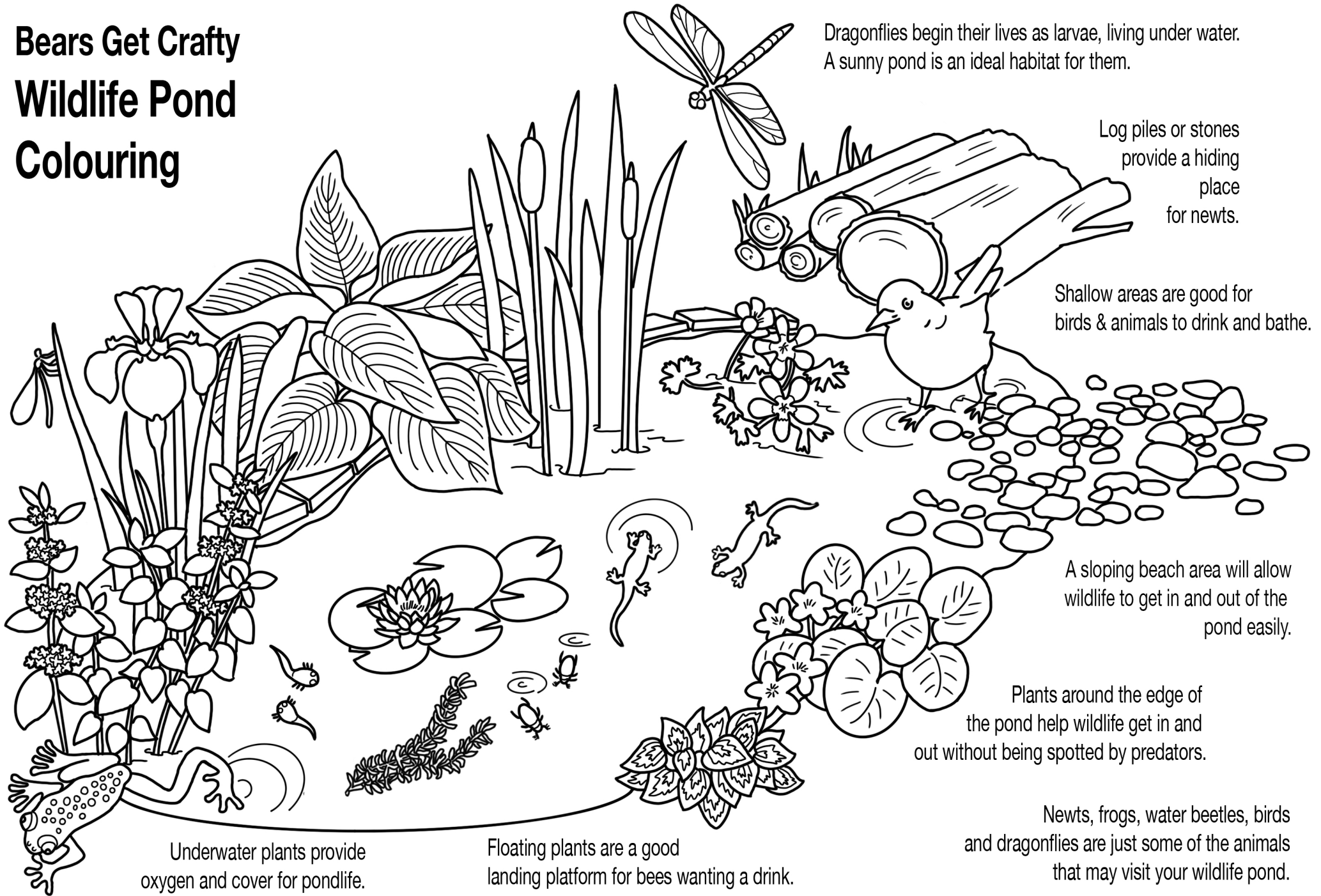


Bears Get Crafty Wildlife Pond Colouring



Dragonflies begin their lives as larvae, living under water. A sunny pond is an ideal habitat for them.

Log piles or stones provide a hiding place for newts.

Shallow areas are good for birds & animals to drink and bathe.

A sloping beach area will allow wildlife to get in and out of the pond easily.

Plants around the edge of the pond help wildlife get in and out without being spotted by predators.

Newts, frogs, water beetles, birds and dragonflies are just some of the animals that may visit your wildlife pond.

Underwater plants provide oxygen and cover for pondlife.

Floating plants are a good landing platform for bees wanting a drink.
